*Prime Change-Out Dates: Feb 15, June 5, Sept 25, Dec 7. By scheduling the change-out of your annuals as close to these dates as possible, you will obtain the longest possible flowering time for each change-out.

*Bed Preparation: Dispose of all old plants, weeds, mulch, etc. Changing out sections or pulling and replacing certain plants will just spread disease to the new ones quickly. Remove and discard soil medium to a depth of at least 8" at least once yearly at the start of autumn. Mulching flowerbeds is not recommended except around the perimeter. Sprinkle a granular fertilizer like nutricote over the top.
