<b>Oranges</b>	<b>Ht x Width</b>	<b>Seed #</b>	<b>Fruit Diam</b>	<b>Harvest Season</b>	<b>Description</b>
Hamlin	20'x 15'	0 to 6	2.75-3"	Oct - Jan	Early juice orange, heavy yields.
Midsweet	20'x 15'	6 to 24	2.75-3"	Jan - Mar	Juice orange, more cold hardy.
Navel	20'x 15'	0 to 6	3-3.5"	Sept - Jan	Fruit peels easily for hand eating.
Red Navel 'Cara Cara'	20'x 15'	0 to 6	3-3.5"	Sept - Jan	Better yield than standard navel.
Roble	20'x20'	0 to 6	2.75-3"	Oct - Jan	Similar to Parson Brown.
Pineapple	20'x 15'	0 to 6	2.75-3"	Dec - Mar	Least cold hardy, mid-season.
Valencia	25'x15'	0 to 6	2.75-3"	Mar - June	Most popular juice orange.
Valencia 'Rhode Red'	25'x15'	0 to 6	2.75-3"	Mar - June	Valencia with internal red blush.

**Tangerine and Tangerine Hybrids**

Dancy Tangerine	25'x20'	6 to 20	2.25-2.5"	Dec - Feb	Popular hand eating tangerine.
Florida Mandarin	25'x20'	3 to 7	2.75-3.25"	Nov - Jan	Fruit peels and tastes like tang.
Honeybell Tangelo	25'x20'	7 to 12	3-3.5"	Dec - Feb	V. cold hardy with large fruit.
Honey Tangerine	25'x20'	12 to 20	2.75"	Jan - Mar	Hvy bearer, good eating quality.
Orlando Tangelo	20'x15'	0 to 35	2.75-3"	Nov - Jan	Large cold hardy tree.
Ponkan Mandarin	20'x15'	3 to 7	2.75-3.25"	Dec - Jan	Superb seedless, easy peeler.
Robinson Tangerine	25'x20'	1 to 20	2.5-2.75"	Sept - Dec	Excellent eating quality.
Satsuma Mandarin	25'x20'	0 to 6	2.25-2.5"	Sept - Nov	Very cold hardy, best in N Florida.
Sunburst Tangerine	25'x20'	1 to 20	2.5-3"	Oct - Dec	Highly colored fruit, ships well.
Temple Orange	25'x20'	15 to 20	2.75-3"	Jan - Mar	V. cold sensitive, excellent eating.

**Grapefruit**

Duncan	25'x20'	30 to 60	3.5-5"	Nov - June	Seedy white grapefruit, high qual.
Marsh	25'x20'	0 to 6	3.5-4.5"	Nov - June	White seedless, good quality.
Thompson Pink	25'x20'	0 to 6	3.75-4.5"	Dec - June	Pale pink internal flesh.
Ruby Red	25'x20'	0 to 6	3.5-4.5"	Nov - June	Pale red flesh.

**Lemons**

Bearss	20'x10'	1 to 6	2.25-3.5"	July - Dec	Cold sensitive, large vigorous tree
Meyers	15'x20'	0 to 10	2.25-3"	Nov - Mar	Most cold hardy lemon.
Ponderosa	20'x10'	50 to 70	3.5-4.25"	July - June	Large softball size fruit.
Variegated	25'x20'	0 to 6	2-2.5"	July - Dec	Var. foliage w/ red flesh.

**Limes**

Key Lime	10'x5'	3 to 8	1.25-1.75"	July - June	Cold sensitive, smaller tree.
Persian Lime	15'x10'	0 to 1	1.75-2.25"	June - Sept	Cold sensitive, good patio plant.

**Miscellaneous**

Calamondin	15'x5'	3 to 5	1.25-1.5"	Nov - April	Acidic fruit used in drinks & jelly.
Nagami Kumquat	15'x5'	0 to 3	0.75-1.25"	Nov - April	Cold hardy, tart fruit.
Meiwa Kumquat	15'x5'	1 to 3	1.25-1.5"	Nov - April	Cold hardy, sweeter taste.
